EVALUATION FIELDS

1. Scientific Activity

1.1 The three most important outcomes/results of my research are:

- Studies of agri-environmental policies under the EU Rural Development Programmes. Through several EU Framework Projects I have studied how the policies are designed including the use of underlying evidence (see no. 16 below) and how they are implemented. Development of an agent focused framework for the analysis of policy effects and outcomes was done as part of this work (see no. 20 below) The most important publication in this work and the most quoted is: Primdahl J, Peco B, Andersen E, Schramek J, Oñate JJ. Environmental effects of agri-environmental schemes in Western Europe. *Journal of Environmental Management*. 2003, 67(1):129-138.
- Studies of agricultural landscapes within the context of globalization. This research has included theoretical work in collaboration with professor Simon Swaffield, Lincoln University, New Zealand and fieldwork in New Zealand, Portugal and Denmark. Main outcome has been the book 'Globalisation and the Agricultural Landscape: Change Patterns and Policy Trends in Developed Countries. Co-edited with Simon Swaffield and published by Cambridge University Press in 2010. See also no. 15 and 18 in the list in 1.2 below.
- Studies of landscape change within the context of policy and planning. Through numerous research projects I have studied how and with what outcomes the farmers' landscape practices are affected by policy and planning (see no 9 below). These studies include the rural hinterland as well as peri-urban landscape. Through investigations of different landscapes within on the greater Copenhagen Metropolitan area I have analysed the longer term effects if the Copenhagen Finger Plan (though studies of the same 8 areas in 1984, 1994, 2004 and 2014. (See no. 17 below plus several others in the total list). An important outcome of this research has been better understanding of the roles through which the farmer manage his or her farm. (see no. 12 and 16 below) The most important outcome of these studies has been the book 'European Landscapes In Transition – implications for policy and practice', co-authored with professor Teresa Pinto Correia, University of Evora and associate professor Bas Pedroli, Wageningen University and published by Cambridge University Press in 2018. Especially the chapters on new rural-urban relationships, public policy and planning, and new forms of landscape governance have my footprint. Within this research area we have most recently been involved in action research projects in which we have developed a framework for 'Landscape strategy making' as an approach to a more collaborative, policy integrating and proactive form of countryside planning. 
